

## Parco's Cine Quinto Mini-Theater in Shibuya to Re-Open on Friday July 6, 2018!

PARCO Co., Ltd. ("PARCO") announced today that on Friday July 6, 2018, it would be reopening its Cine Quinto movie theater located inside the Shibuya Mitsuba Building, just a four-minute walk from JR Shibuya Station.

Cine Quinto began operating as a movie theater in July 1999, screening Buffalo '66 as its first film, and since then has shown a number of domestic and foreign productions. The theater was temporarily closed in August 2016 for the reconstruction of Shibuya PARCO, but will start operating again for the first time in almost two years as a two-screen theater.

Under the concept of "Entertainment from around the world," Cine Quinto screens high-quality domestic and foreign productions of all genres. Until now, Cine Quinto was a one-screen theater, but it will be reopened as a two-screen theater in order to provide even more entertainment for customers. These features and the introduction of pair seats that are unique in Shibuya will combine to make Cine Quinto one of the area's most engaging movie theaters.

The success of PARCO's movie business is based on the support customers have shown for the productions purchased and distributed by the company, such as "Dancer" and "Loving Vincent." PARCO takes pride in screening high-quality artistic independent productions, and is working hard to bring diverse foreign and domestic entertainment to the Shibuya area.

Cine Quinto will expand together with the newly reborn Shibuya PARCO through joint planning and event operation, working together to contribute to the vibrancy of the entire Shibuya area.
